



Advanced Apprentices

Celebrate in style for the second year

MORE than 500 guests attended the second successful Advanced Apprenticeship Graduation ceremony held on October 5 at Hull City Hall.

Of these, more than 400 young people from across the Humber sub-region achieved their Advanced Apprenticeship between April 2006 and March 2007.

And 113 Advanced Apprentices attended the unique event, along with family, friends, employers and the apprenticeship providers that delivered their training, development and support.

The ceremony was opened by Steve Roe, chief executive of the Consortium for Learning (CfL). CfL is an umbrella organisation representing the network of apprenticeship providers across the Humber sub-region.

Steve added: “Apprenticeship frameworks are designed to meet the future needs of all industries. They are not an easy option.

“Advanced Apprenticeships are tough frameworks to complete, requiring absolute commitment and determination from everyone involved.

“Our local area is often criticised for under performing, but we have evidence, here today, of a group of young people, employers and providers that have worked hard, in partnership, to contribute to increasing the skills in our area”.

Steve was joined by Linda Ainsworth, partnership director for the Learning and Skills Council (LSC) Humberside.

Linda said: “The skills our graduates today now have, will enable them to be flexible, change when needed, stay in work and even to create work and opportunities for others.

“They can expect greater chances to develop themselves and their careers.

“They will actually make a real difference to the companies they work in, they will improve the productivity of those companies and gain greater satisfaction from their work.”

The LSC exists to make England better skilled and more competitive.

It is responsible for planning and funding high quality education and training for everyone in England other than those in universities.

Linda said: “Our ability to compete and be successful depends upon our skilled people, it is known that skilled people can adapt more easily to changing situations, new ways of working and new markets, you’ve made a good decision.”

Tammy Aldred, development manager for CfL, led the presentation of the certificates.

The Advanced Apprentices were dressed in mortar boards and presented with a scroll by Steve Roe and Linda Ainsworth.

Steve said: “Apprenticeships have been around for a long time and the government is providing increased investment to ensure that apprenticeships help address the increasing skills needed by our nation to compete in a global economy.

“We have a very strong network of local apprenticeship providers who are passionate about what they do.

These providers have a long tradition of engaging with local employers, in the development of our local young people and are wholly committed to the apprenticeship route”

“This three-way partnership [apprentice, employer and provider] could not have been achieved without the investment of the government in

contributing to the cost of providing the training and development.”

This funding is distributed to the apprenticeship providers through the LSC and he thanked the local LSC for their ongoing support.

Steve also thanked the sponsors of the prestigious event including LSC Humberside, OCR and local employers Ideal Standard, Harris, Lacey and Swain and Kaye Middleton Accountants.

Special thanks were given to apprenticeship providers for their contribution to the ceremony and other supporters that helped to make the ceremony a success.

This year’s ceremony included a special award, the Jane Welsh Memorial award, which was sponsored by Kaplan Financial.

The award recognises achievement in the face of adversity due to personal, social or employment difficulty.
